Overview of role



Wanstead and Woodford Migrant Support (WWMS) is a charity that assists migrants in our locality through the provision of advocacy, advice and support services. Clients access our services through a range of remote and in-person appointments. Many of our clients have experienced homelessness, destitution, or are vulnerable in another way.

We are expanding our services to include coffee mornings, where migrants living locally can come to socialise, learn English in a social setting, relax and learn about other local services. This is an exciting opportunity to play a key role in these mornings to create a welcoming environment, meet new people and develop skills. It is an ideal role for warm, friendly people with excellent communication skills who would like to make a difference.

We are an equal opportunity organisation and strongly encourage applications from those with lived experience of migration, and from diverse applicants regardless of age, disability, gender reassignment, marital/civil partnership status, race, religion or belief, sex, sexual orientation, or pregnancy/maternity leave status.

Main Tasks and Responsibilities

The Coffee Morning Volunteer will assist with:

- Setting up the welcome space with chairs and activities
- Greeting people when they arrive
- Making refreshments
- Games
- English conversation for those who are interested
- Putting attendees at ease and making conversation
- Ensuring the welcome space is health and safety compliant
